Federal Financial Aid Programs

Pell Grants. For those who demonstrate “exceptional financial need.”
Maximum award amounts: One-year: \$5,550. Two-year: \$8,300.

Stafford Loans. For independent students.
Maximum award amounts: One-year: \$9,500. Two-year: \$14,750.

Parent Plus Loans. For parents with dependents.
Maximum award amounts: One-year: \$10,300. Two-year: \$15,900.

How to Apply for Federal Financial Aid

Step 1. Contact the BCMT financial aid advisor or a BCMT admissions coordinator before you begin the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) process. They will provide tips on expediting your application and ensuring success.

Step 2. Visit www.fafsa.ed.gov to submit your application(s). The BCMT school code is 030131.

Step 3. Submit your Application for Admission to the BCMT admissions department.

Step 4. Upon receipt of your Application for Admission, the BCMT financial aid office will send you a financial aid package. Complete the documents in this package and mail them back to BCMT.

Congratulations! You have now completed the financial aid process. If your financial aid request has been approved, you will receive an Estimated Award Letter in 2-3 weeks. If you choose to accept the award, follow the attached instructions.

Other Types of Financial Aid

BCMT Scholarships. “Presidential” and “Ken Morgareidge” awards.

Career, Alternative or Private Loans. Offered by private lending institutions.

Other Funding Sources. BCMT accepts tuition funds from 529 Tuition Plans, Vocational Rehabilitation Funds, Veterans Benefits (VA), Americorps, and unaffiliated scholarships.
